Alonzo is a Consultant with Triad Consulting Group, where he helps organizations, teams and individuals increase their capacity to negotiate and navigate difficult conversations.

He is also a Lecturer on Law and the Associate Director of East Asian Legal Studies at Harvard Law School. Alonzo taught the flagship Negotiation Workshop at Harvard Law School and designed the Negotiation Workshop for 1Ls, to increase the practicality of legal education. He has facilitated executive education programs at the Harvard Negotiation Institute, helping leaders from around the world prepare to navigate difficult conversations and complex negotiations.

From 2013 to 2016, Alonzo served as a Clinical Instructor in the Harvard Negotiation and Mediation Clinical Program where he managed clinical teams working on dispute systems design, consensus building, mediation, community dialogue, and facilitation projects. Alonzo was an Assistant Professor of Comparative Jurisprudence at Renmin University of China Law School in Beijing where he taught courses on negotiation as well as international and U.S. law. Before entering academic teaching, Alonzo was a summer associate at Davis Polk & Wardwell and Shearman & Sterling.

Through his clinical and consulting practice, Alonzo has worked with hundreds of corporate executives, lawyers, judges, civil society leaders, government officials, and educators from around the world in developing negotiation and conflict management strategies. He has led projects and workshops for Hewlett Packard, the Asian Development Bank, the U.S. Department of Justice's Community Relations Service, the National Institutes of Health, the U.S. Office of Special Counsel, the Natural Resources Defense Council, and JSW Law School in the Kingdom of Bhutan, among others.
